

Stowe Mountain Resort Named One of the Best Places to Work in Vermont

STOWE, Vt. - May 2017 - Stowe Mountain Resort was recently named as one of the **2017 Best Places to Work in Vermont**. The tenth annual list of the *Best Places to Work in Vermont* was created by *Vermont Business Magazine*, the Vermont Chamber of Commerce, the Vermont Department of Economic Development, the Vermont Department of Labor, the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) - Vermont State Council and Best Companies Group.

Companies from across the state entered the two-part survey process to determine the *Best Places to Work in Vermont*. The first part consisted of evaluating each nominated company's workplace policies, practices, philosophy, systems and demographics. This part of the process was worth approximately 25% of the total evaluation. The second part consisted of an employee survey to measure the employee experience. This part of the process was worth approximately 75% of the total evaluation. The combined scores determined the top companies and the final rankings.
