skiing and riding across Northstar, Heavenly, Stevens Pass, and Park City. These scholarships—covering lift tickets, group lessons, and gear rentals—help remove barriers, create community, and inspire the next generation of diverse leaders in the industry.

Northstar's commitment to elevating women extends beyond events. With Tara Schoedinger stepping in as Vice President & General Manager, she continues the resort's legacy as the fifth consecutive woman in this role—a testament to Northstar's longstanding leadership in fostering women's growth in the ski industry.
